3 Summer Employment Positions

(12 weeks duration, June-August 2022)

Alford Lake Camp is located in the foothills of Central Alberta, 20 km west of Caroline. Throughout the summer months, many groups attend the camp to participate in and learn about a variety of outdoor activities. These groups include students from Junior and Senior High schools, youth clubs (such as Junior Forest Wardens, Scouts, Cadets, etc.), as well as a few adult groups.

Working under the direction of a camp manager, candidates may act in a supervisory capacity helping to educate Albertans about a variety of Conservation Education programs. This position provides a great opportunity to improve your public speaking, public relations and compliance enforcement skills. Successful applicants need to be self-motivated and able to work with minimal supervision.

Accommodations, meal allowance and all necessary equipment will be supplied to successful applicants. Washing machines, showers, cooking facilities are on site. Vehicles and off-highway vehicles provided for all job duties.
