

Introduction to Fall Protection

The responsibilities of both employer and worker are covered, as well as the regulations governing fall protection.	 Need for fall protection training. Four components of a complete fall protection system. Calculations required for determining minimum clearance requirements. Maintenance and use criteria for fall protection equipment. Types of fall protection systems. Requirements of developing a fall protection program. Post fall and rescue planning. Competencies The competencies of this program are tested through a knowledge-based examination, and through 100% participation in the program. Participants must achieve a minimum pass mark of 70% on a written competency exam.
