

## **2023-2024 Grants for AHEIA NASP Schools**

All certified AHEIA NASP schools are eligible to apply for funding, in the form of grants, to aid in purchasing or upgrading their archery equipment for the 2023-2024 school year.

There are two separate grants available to each school and it is important to note that each grant has a particular application deadline; please read all application details carefully to ensure deadlines are not missed.

Applications for both grants are to be submitted to AHEIA, and all forthcoming equipment grant decisions will be made by AHEIA.

It is our hope that Alberta AHEIA NASP schools will be introduced to, and/or improve their AHEIA NASP programs, with the intent of participating in future regional, provincial, local, and national NASP tournaments.

## **GRANT DETAILS AND APPLICATION GUIDELINES**

### **AHEIA NASP Grant**

This reimbursement grant is for the purchase of AHEIA NASP equipment from any archery supplier, including NASP. It is in Canadian dollars and is available to first time purchasers and schools upgrading existing equipment. This grant is available on a first-come/first-serve basis until all available funds have been allocated.

- Schools will receive a reimbursement of 50% (to a maximum of \$500.00) on the purchase of equipment.
- For any NASP equipment including tournament equipment and 3D targets.

### **Procedure**

- A) Purchase equipment through NASP or any archery retailer.
- B) **Send copies of paid equipment invoices/receipts** via email to AHEIA NASP Co-ordinator, Dave Paplawski: [dave@aheia.com](mailto:dave@aheia.com).  
The email must also include the following information:
  - school name
  - school address and phone number
  - NASP BAI certified teacher's name and contact email address
  - whether this is a new or existing AHEIA NASP school
- C) **DEADLINE** to submit paid invoices and receipts is **February 16, 2024**.
- D) If your school is approved for a grant you will be notified by email.  
A cheque will be mailed to the school in the spring of 2024.

## NASP Grant

This grant is in the form of a discount on the purchase of equipment directly from NASP. It is in U.S. dollars and is available to first time purchasers and schools upgrading existing equipment.

A) New Schools:

- Up to \$1,500/per school.
- School must purchase full set of equipment (\$3,300 minimum).
- Must order complete set of equipment including bows, targets, arrows, safety curtain, bow rack and maintenance kit.

B) Existing Schools Upgrading:

- Schools will receive a discount of 50% (to a maximum of \$400.00) on the purchase of equipment.
- For upgrading archery equipment only (no score cards, paper faces or scanners).

**Deadline to qualify is March 31, 2024.**

### Procedure

Step 1:

- A) Send an email to AHEIA NASP Co-ordinator, Dave Paplawski: [dave@aheia.com](mailto:dave@aheia.com).  
The email must include the following information:
- school name
  - school address and phone number
  - NASP BAI certified teacher's name and contact email address
  - whether this is a new or existing NASP school
  - school ID number (found on NASP website under your approved school name – [www.naspschools.org](http://www.naspschools.org))
- B) AHEIA will verify application and if approved grant will provide the information to NASP

Step 2:

- A) Once approved you will be supplied with a current Canada NASP order form.
- B) Place your order with NASP – **Deadline to order equipment is April 30, 2024.**
- C) When placing the order with NASP, make a notation on the order form that your school has been approved and has been authorized to receive the NASP grant. **Without this notation on the order form, the grant dollars will not be deducted from the total invoice cost.**
- D) Put your school's Custom Broker's contact name and information in your email to NASP with your order form attached.
- E) The school will be invoiced in U.S. dollars for the amount of your order **less the amount of the grant.**
- F) Equipment will be shipped from NASP suppliers.
